Gather near the bandstand to hear seasonal messages from three special guests: Mayor Corrigan, Peter Webb, Senior Vice President of Development at Concord Pacific and Stephen D'Souza, Executive Director of Burnaby Community Services. Using the magic of the season, the lights on our huge Maple Tree will brighten at their command "Make it Bright in Burnaby".

Enjoy light refreshments of cocoa or apple cider will be served after the ceremony (while supplies last). Stations will be set up at the end of Hill Street, near the Steam Shed, and at the Vorce tram station.

The carousel is a vintage machine that has its own magical way of creating smiles. On this night only, there is an additional good-will opportunity. The City of Burnaby will donate the proceeds of all carousel ticket sales to the Burnaby Christmas Bureau. Concord Pacific will be matching the sales to double the donation total. Help the Bureau make Christmas bright for many in our community – buy carousel tickets tonight!

Visitors are encouraged to come early and stay late as there will be much to see and do. Guests can wander the streets of our Village, stepping into the shops and homes to see the displays and chat with our townsfolk. The revamped Twelve Days of Christmas scavenger hunt will challenge and amuse. Wonder at the spectacular light displays, enjoy the creative eco-sculpture settings and snap your photo sitting in the Santa Sleigh!
